

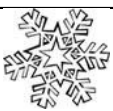

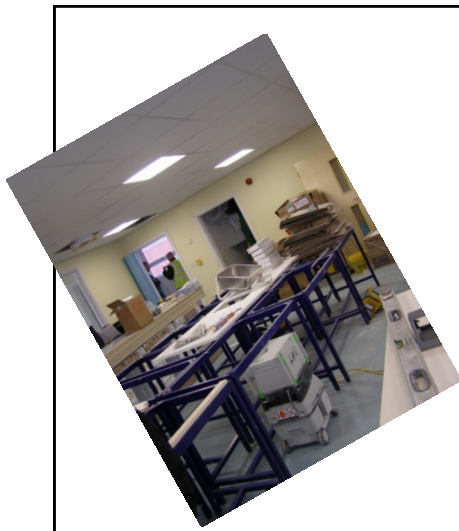

The New Food Technology Room with an additional area to support enrichment is going well.

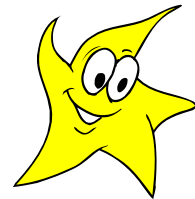
The building is now up and the team are working hard to get the interior finished.
